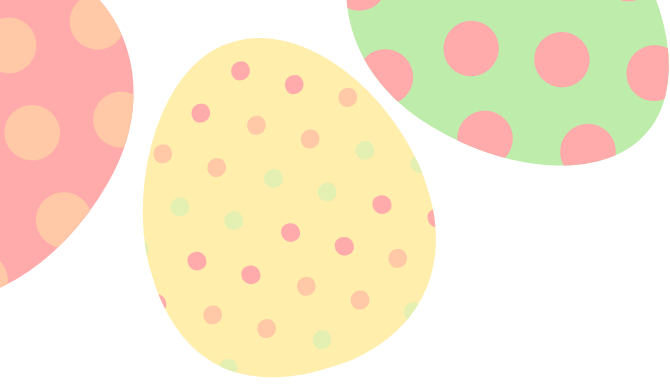




# HARBS COLLECTIVE EASTER TRAIL

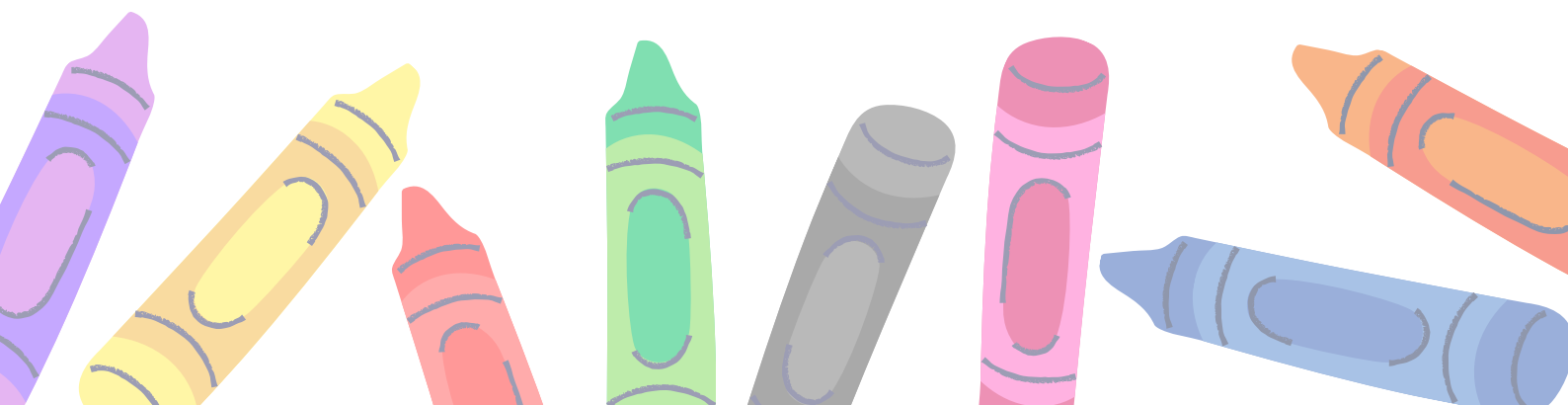
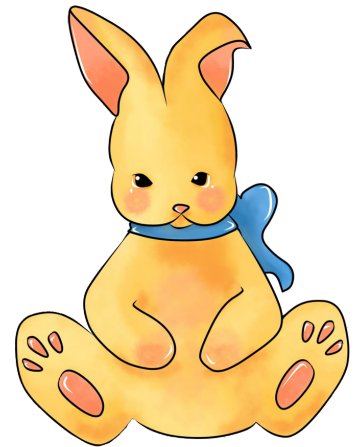

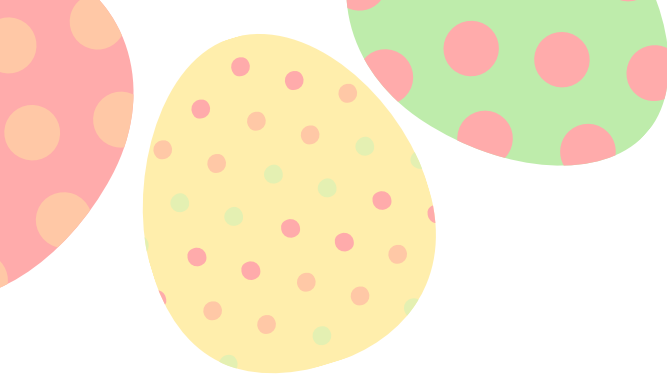
